NOTES: Restrooms are available at the parking lot. Most trails are on dirt. Trails close for three days following rain.

OCCNPS would like to welcome Board and Council members and friends to one of the most beautiful parks in Orange County, O'Neill Regional Park. A splendid drive through a coast live oak forest leads to the entrance of the park, which encompasses lush woodland and coastal sage scrub. We will take an easy walk on a series of trails on the eastern portion of the park, highlighting the extensive stands of chaparral nolina (*Nolina cismontana*) that are a highlight of the park. Early wildflowers such as wild cucumber (*Marah macrocarpa*), California peony (*Paeonia californica*) and California bells (*Phacelia minor*) are now in peak bloom. We hope all who attend will enjoy one of the best natural parks among many in Orange County!
